Essential Functions, Duties, and Responsibilities:

- Constructs and builds structures and other park amenities.
- May lead seasonal workers, overseeing and coordinating work.

Additional Examples of Work Performed

- Assists with City's snow removal operation; including on-call nights and weekends.
- Assists with set up and cleanup of special events.
- Assists the Recreation Division with programs as needed.
- Provides proper maintenance of fountains, planters or other grounds features.
- Services and inspects playgrounds, swimming pools and structures for hazards and safety issues.
- Cleans picnic shelters and picnic areas.

Qualifications

Minimum: High school diploma or G.E.D. and one year of work experience in facility maintenance. Must have a valid driver's license; Must be available to be on call as needed, with overtime, weekend and holiday work required.
