# **Position Summary**

The Parks Crew Leader – Forestry oversees and assists with the general maintenance of the City's urban forest. Duties include leading and directing regular and/or seasonal/temporary employees.

## **Key Responsibilities**

- Performs arboriculture and forestry related maintenance duties on City property, including, but not limited to, pruning, planting, chemical applications, and felling to ensure the health and safety of the urban forest.
- Leads and directs regular and/or seasonal/temporary employees in the completion of forestry-related duties.
- Maintains detailed department records.
- Assumes daily responsibilities of Parks Landscape Supervisor in his/her short-term absence.
- Operates all forestry equipment and instructs employees in the safe operation of such equipment.
- Assists with management of the City tree nursery including fertilizing, pruning, watering and replacing harvested trees.
- Investigates questions and recommends action on requests made by the public on matters concerning trees, landscaping, grounds maintenance and the tree trimming program.
- On-call availability as needed, with overtime, weekend and holiday work required.

### **Additional Examples of Work Performed**

- Maintains landscape and forestry equipment.
- Assists with special projects including right-of-way tree trimming, right-of-way tree planting, and EAB management.
- Assists with the City's snow removal operation.
- Assists with planning, set up and clean-up of special events.

#### Qualifications

Minimum: High school diploma or G.E.D. and five years of experience in grounds maintenance and forestry; Must possess a valid Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with the following endorsements: airbrakes, combination and tanker, Kansas Pesticide Applicator license - categories 3A and 3B; Kansas Arborist or International Society of Arborists (ISA) certification, or ability to obtain within 12 months.

Desired: Two years of supervisory experience.

**Compensation and Benefits** starting rate of pay is \$19.54 to \$23.89 per hour dependent on qualifications and directly related experience. The City offers a highly competitive compensation package including health, dental, life,
