Job Summary

The Public Works Fleet Supervisor participates in the planning, organizing and directing of the fleet maintenance on City owned vehicles and equipment to ensure the safe and reliability operation. This position is responsible for planning, organizing, directing, managing, and supervising the activities of the Fleet Technicians in the performance of fleet maintenance for the Public Works Department. Responds to citizens and other public entities inquiries, complaints and requests. Coordinates fleet maintenance activities with contractors.

Education and/or Experience

Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Must have a minimum of ten (10) years of experience in automotive/mechanical repair and maintenance with two (2) years of supervisory or lead experience OR An Associate's degree in Automotive Technology or related field with six (6) years of experience with one (1) year of supervisory or lead experience. Three (3) years of supervisory or lead experience, preferred. Supervisory or lead experience includes completing performance appraisals, directing employee's daily work assignments, or evaluating the crew assignments. Must have an EPA airconditioning certification. Must have or be able to obtain Master Automobile & Light Truck Certification, Master Truck Equipment Certification, Master Medium Heavy-Truck Certification and Auto Maintenance Light Repair Certification through Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Institution. Must have a Class A Commercial Drivers License with air brake and tanker endorsements, or acquire within sixty (60) days of hire.
