Job Summary

The Public Works Specialist performs a wide variety of skilled tasks related to the maintenance and construction on City-owned facilities, roadways, installation of City-owned traffic control devices and other City owned infrastructure. Assists in emergency operations, including snow removal, flood response and other natural disasters.

Public Works Specialist operates and is efficient in various types of light to heavy vehicles and equipment. Acts as a lead to Maintenance Workers regarding asphalt and concrete repair, traffic signs and equipment, stormwater management and weather response operations. This position requires moderate decision making with some review and guidance.

Education and/or Experience

Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Must have a minimum of eight (8) years of experience in concrete or street construction or equivalent experience. Ten (10) years of experience, preferred. Completion of NIMS requirements within one year of hire. Must have or be able to obtain within six (6) months of hire, OSHA 10 hour training, Trenching training and Work Zone Certification training through IMSA or other approved credentialing entity. Must have a Class A Commercial Driver's License (CDL) with air brakes and tanker endorsements. Possession of Public Works Technical Certifications, preferred. Certifications include ISMA Safety Training Work Zone Technician, APWA Public Works Institute, or equivalent Technical Certification. Must possess a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record per the City's drivers *Use of Vehicles for City Business* policy throughout employment with the City.
