## **General Responsibilities**

Assist and support the Leadership team by performing a variety of semi-skilled and skilled general maintenance work, including light maintenance duties, minor gardening and routine custodial duties in recreation facilities, playgrounds, parks, and adjacent grounds and landscaping beds.

## **Qualifications**

High school diploma or equivalent desired.

Minimum of one year experience in landscaping, grounds keeping, native plant care, forestry, or a related field required.

Prior experience with maintenance and custodial work desired.

Valid Class B CDL within 120 days of employment required. A valid driver's license is required upon hire.

Minimum of 18 years of age.
