- 'Unmute' to speak. 'Mute' all other times for less 'noise' on call. (Long press Space Bar to briefly unmute):** (points to the Unmute button in the bottom center).
- New Security Function:** (points to the Security button in the bottom center).
- The Host can invite more people from inside Participant window:** (points to the Participants button in the bottom center).
